SUNDAY'S READINGS 1st Reading: Micah 5:1-4 Psalm: 79:2-3,15-16,18-19 2nd Reading: Hebrews 10:5-10 Gospel: Luke 1:39-45

My dear Friends:

Well, here we are about to celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent! The Fourth Advent Candle is named the Angel Candle. It is the symbol of Jesus as the bearer of Peace. I think, possibly, Jesus, as Weaver of Peace might be a more accurate description! Jesus came among us to weave us together, a global family, woven and bonded together, by God's love, peace, justice compassion and forgiveness. As we hear in today's gospel, Mary's cousin, Elizabeth, experienced her child 'leaping with joy' when Mary visited them.

The warm and beautiful Christmas 'scene' of salvation is created! After months of anxiety, fear and disappointment about Covid 19, we await in a state of excited exaltation, with renewed hope, to celebrate with family and friends, Jesus' birth. Then, out of the blue, the gathering of threatening clouds in the form of the mutant virus! *Omicron*, appears in our midst! However, it was into a world of fear and darkness that Jesus, the Light of the World, was born. At this moment in time, when our world sometimes feels filled with uncertainties, fears and anxieties, that same Light of Hope, Faith, Joy and Peace (symbolised in the Advent candles) is born again!

Like the shepherds and Magi, we will experience that 'guiding star' of God's loving presence to help and guide us in these challenging times. We know that the Jesus, whose birth we are celebrating, walks every step of this everevolving Covid experience with us. His love embraces us. It supports us. It assures us that we are not alone on this journey. Like Mary, especially in our love and compassion, we can become the *God-Bearer* for the people we meet each day. Each one of us, in our words and actions, can be a light in their darkness; a fountain of hope in their distress; a source of comfort in their loneliness and isolation... In the words, I have quoted from Teresa of Avila, in my 'Christmas Blessings':

Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which he looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which he blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are his body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours
