ROSARY IN OCTOBER


Every Wednesday in October, 7 pm **Lady Chapel at Immaculate Conception**

On October 7th, the Church celebrates the feast day of Mary, Queen of the Holy Rosary. The feast day was established by Pope Saint Pius V. on the anniversary of the victory at Lepanto on October 7 1571, which was attributed to the Virgin Mary whose intercession was entreated through the recitation of the Holy Rosary.

The Church then proceeded to dedicate the entire month of October to the Holy Rosary so that individuals, families, and communities would pray the Holy Rosary, if possible, on a daily basis for peace in the world.

Please join us in October for the Rosary, this best known of all Catholic devotions.

BAPTISM

If you would like your child to be baptised you will need to firstly download and complete a baptism registration form (visit our website at www.immaculateconception.church, go to the 'Documents' tab and click on 'Forms' on the drop down list. Here you will find the baptism registration form. This should be returned to the parish office. You will then need to make contact with Deacon Gerard after one of the Sunday Masses to discuss further and make suitable arrangements.

MASS INTENTIONS

 There are envelopes in the church porch on which you can complete your request and enclose any donation you would like to make to the parish priest. These can be handed to Fr Anthony or Deacon Gerard after Mass, posted into the presbytery or brought into the parish office.

ST JOHN'S CATHOLIC CATHEDRAL PORTSMOUTH

Due to deterioration in the leadwork of the Cathedral West window (the large one at the front), specialist contractors have had to remove the glass for restoration costing more than £100,000. 

As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. John 15:9a (NIV)


