Most importantly, change to the church starts with individuals, so where you can, try to focus, in each instance, first of all on the question of 'what changes need to be made in "myself". It is easy to say what the parish or the diocese should be doing, but change starts in each one of us in many different ways.

DO YOU NEED A COVID VACCINATION?

Grab a Jab from the **University Health Service**, Building 48, Highfield Campus SO17 1BJ. For <u>anyone</u> to get a **1st, 2nd or booster dose** on the following **walk-in** dates:

- · Sunday 23rd January 10am-4pm
- · Sunday 30th January 10am-4pm
- · Saturday 5th February 1pm-5pm
- · Saturday 12th February 1pm-5pm
- We are open to anyone aged 12 and over
- For the second dose, under 18s need to wait 12 weeks after the first. Over 18s need to wait 8 weeks after the first.
- Boosters can be given to anyone over 16 from 3 months after the second dose.
- You do not need to have an NHS number, you don't need to be registered with a GP, and we don't carry out any identity checks. We do not check immigration status. We can, however, offer advice on how to register with a GP if you wish to.
- If you have previously been partially vaccinated in another country, you can still finish off the vaccination course here. If you come as a walkin patient, we will be able to advise further.
- We have staff who speak a few different languages, but otherwise all information you need is written so can be translated if needed.
