

Jesus said to the disciples, "Go everywhere in the world. Tell the Good News to everyone. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved but he who does not believe will be judged guilty. Those who believe will be able to do these things as proof: They will use my name to force demons out of people. They will speak in languages they never learned. They will pick up snakes without being hurt and they will drink poison without being hurt. They will touch the sick and the sick will be healed." After the Lord Jesus said these things to the disciples, **he was carried up into heaven.** There, Jesus sat at the right side of God. The disciples went everywhere in the world and told the Good News to people. The Lord proved that the Good News they told was true by giving them power to work miracles.

The Gospel is the Good News about Jesus!










Jesus prays for his disciples

John 17: 11-19

I will remain in the world no longer but they are still in the world. I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one. While I was with them I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. None has been lost except (Judas) the one doomed to destruction so that Scripture would be fulfilled. "I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.

Does God Always Answer Our Prayers?


God doesn't always answer our prayers the way we want or expect.

When we pray in Jesus' name (ask for what Jesus wants), God gives us what we ask for.



When we ask for the wrong thing or for the wrong reason, God may not give us what we ask for.


